New Dental Technology Available In Our Office...

We are always excited when we get new technology that allows us to provide better care for our patients. We are thrilled to tell you about our new CAD CAM system that produces restorations such as crowns.

CAD CAM, or computer assisted design and computer assisted manufacturing, is used to design and fabricate crowns made without metal, quicker and with fantastic results.

Traditionally, crowns are made from mouth impressions done in the office and then handcrafted from molds. They usually take seven to ten days to make. CAD CAM scanners use computer technology to laser scan the tooth that will be crowned. This makes for a highly accurate, high-precision crown that is available in no later than two days. This added benefit comes at no additional cost to you!

Dr. Rosenblat has already fitted many crowns using this new technology. We are pleased to inform you that our CAD CAM scanner will arrive soon. Give us a call and ask us about the benefits of our new system. We'd be happy to give you more information.
